

Uniform Policy

In Edenmore National School it is policy that the uniform must be worn on every school day except for sports days when the school tracksuit must be worn.

School Uniform for Boys:

- ✓ Navy Tailored Trousers
- ✓ Blue V-neck jumper with school crest
- ✓ Tie
- ✓ White Shirt
- ✓ Black/Navy Plain Footwear



School Uniform for Girls

- ✓ Navy Tailored Trousers/ Navy Knee-length skirt/ pinafore
- ✓ Blue V-neck jumper or cardigan with school crest
- ✓ Knee length plain navy socks/Tights
- ✓ Tie
- ✓ White Shirt/Blouse
- ✓ Black/Navy Plain Footwear
- ✗ No leggings or tracksuit bottoms permitted



P.E. Uniform

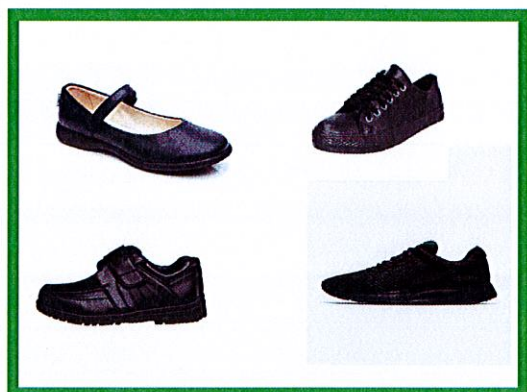
The school tracksuit is recognised as part of the school uniform and pupils most wear it on sports days (Tuesdays and Thursdays)

This consists of:

- ✓ Plain navy round-necked jumper with school crest
- ✓ Plain white polo shirt
- ✓ Plain navy tracksuit bottoms
- ✓ Black/Navy Plain Footwear
- ✗ No leggings permitted
- ✗ No sports jerseys permitted



✓ **Approved school footwear**
(ie. Plain shoes and runners)



✗ **Non-approved footwear**



Jewellery

Small amounts of jewellery are permitted such as a watch and/or mall stud earring. Larger pieces of jewellery attract too much attention and hinder children's concentration. No make-up, high heel shoes or body piercings are allowed.

Make-up

Make-up, fake tan, fake nails/eyelashes etc are not permitted in school.

Summer Uniform Options

In the Summer months children may wear navy shorts to the knee similar to that shown in Figure 2.1

On P.E. days, children may wear plain navy cotton shorts similar to those shown in Figure 2.2.

Football shorts or bermuda shorts will not be permitted.

- Parents must label their child's uniform clearly and a name should also be marked on coats.
- Parents can choose to sew on the school crest onto both the tracksuit top and the school jumper, or we now offer the option to buy school jumpers with crests embedded in the jumper.
- If a child is wearing the incorrect uniform, it is essential that they have a note to explain the reason for this.





Le Chéile
